

## Peace and Nonviolence in the Caucasus Training

### CALL FOR PARTICIPANTS

**Deadline:** 12 July 2014  
**Open to:** Armenian, Azerbaijani, Czech, Georgian, and Polish youth  
between 18 and 24 years old.  
**Dates:** 4–10 August 2014  
**Venue:** Tianeti region, Georgia

**Description.** The **Centre for Cultural Relations – Caucasian House** announces a youth training in themes related to **peace, conflict, mediation, negotiation, and nonviolence**. The training will provide the participants with basic theoretical understanding of conflict dynamics as well as with practical tools used for conflict management. The participants will have a chance to develop their interest in the field and gain a first-hand experience connected to conflict-related issues. The training will be held in a rural area in the vicinity of the town of Tianeti famous for its pristine nature. Recreational activities will allow the participants to get immersed in the Georgian culture and connect to the nature. The training is organised in the framework of the *Youth in Action* programme thanks to financial support of the Education, Audio-visual, and Culture Executive Agency of the European Commission.



**Eligibility.** Young people from Armenia, Azerbaijani, Czech Republic, Georgia, and Poland between 18 and 24 years old are eligible to apply. Prospective participants should demonstrate interest in themes related to peace and conflict and should have **no previous experience** in participation in this kind of trainings. A preference will be given to applicants from rural regions and smaller urban centres. Additionally, applicants from the Czech Republic and Poland should demonstrate interest and basic knowledge about the Caucasus region. All participants should speak English at communicative level.

**Costs.** The organiser will **all costs** (accommodation, board, etc.) during the training and **70% of travel costs** to the training venue. The international transportation costs will be partially reimbursed **after** the participants' arrival to Georgia based on the travel documents.
